WHEREAS, the New York State Department of Labor has provided allocations to Dutchess County for the operation of PY 2014 Title 1B Youth funding for the period of 04/01/14 through 06/30/16 and for the operation of PY 2014 Title 1B Administration funding for the period of 07/01/14 through 06/30/16 and for the operation of FY 2012 TAA funding for the period 10/01/11 through 9/30/14, now, therefore be it

This letter is to notify you that the New York State Department of Labor (NYSDOL) has approved the Local Workforce Investment Area's (LWIA's) requests for additional funds to support the provision of services under the Trade Adjustment Assistance Program (TAA) in accordance with New York State Workforce Development System Technical Advisory #04-6 (May 18, 2004).
