WHEREAS, Bruce Coneeny has expressed an interest in being appointed to said Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Chairman has appointed Bruce Coneeny to the Veterans Affairs Committee subject to confirmation by the Dutchess County Legislature; now, therefore, be it

WHEREAS, at the present time there is no formal committee to advise the County Legislature with respect to those matters relating to veterans affairs, and

WHEREAS, it would be appropriate to create such a committee so that the Legislature may be fully advised and informed prior to taking any action which may affect the many veterans who reside within the county, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Dutchess County Legislature does hereby create a special Advisory Committee to be known as the "Veterans Affairs Committee" to consist of the following members:


- 1) eight member veterans from the private sector, and



Legislators COOPER, SEARS, HUTCHINGS, KELLY, HORTON offer the following and move its adoption:

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 314 of 1995, the Dutchess County Legislature did create a Veterans Affairs Committee to advise the County Legislature with respect to those matters relating to veteran affairs to consist of eight member veterans from the private sector and four county legislators to be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the Chairman of the County Legislature subject to confirmation by the County Legislature, and

WHEREAS, the previous resolution did not assign expiration dates to appointments in its original composition that in part has led to the committee's inactive status, and


WHEREAS, new membership and fresh ideas are the lifeblood of any organization, it is desirable to establish expiration dates for all appointments while also not creating term limits thus affording new involvement without barring the seasoned experience of the current committee membership, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Veterans Affairs Committee shall be reactivated to continue to advise the Legislature on matters affecting Veterans within the County of Dutchess and shall continue to periodically report to the Legislature with respect thereto, and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the Veterans Affairs Committee shall continue to consist of eight member veterans and four county legislators, said members to be appointed by the Chairman of the County Legislature, subject to the confirmation by the County Legislature for staggered terms of two years each with expiration dates of November 30th of each year such that the first six appointments expire after one year, the second set of six serve for two years, and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the chairman of the Veterans Affairs Committee shall be determined by committee members therein on an annual basis.


