RE: AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO EXECUTE THE ATTESTATION CONFIRMING THAT FUNDING INCREASES WILL BE USED TO SUPPORT SALARY AND SALARY RELATED FRINGE BENEFIT COSTS OF CERTAIN COUNTY STAFF AND/OR STAFF AT NOT-FOR-PROFIT PROVIDERS

Legislators FLESLAND, BORCHERT, MICCIO, BOLNER, PULVER, ROMAN, SAGLIANO, LANDISI, and TRUITT offer the following and move its adoption:

Pursuant to Part I of Chapter 60 of the New York State Laws of 2014.

WHEREAS, the New York State 2014-2015 enacted budget included funding for the provision of a 2 percent increase in annual salary and salary related fringe benefit costs for Direct Support and Direct Care staff and Clinical staff at municipal and not-for-profit providers that became effective on or after January 1, 2014, and paid during the period January 1, 2015 through March 31, 2015, and

WHEREAS, additionally, the statute provides funding for up to an additional 2 percent increases for these staff effective April 1, 2015, for any increases that became effective on or after January 1, 2014, and

WHEREAS, the statute requires each provider to submit an attestation confirming that the funding increases will be used solely to support salary and salary related fringe benefit increases, and, now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his designee be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to execute an attestation certifying that the State-aid funding for Direct Care Worker Program provided to the County will be used solely to provide salary increases and salary related fringe benefit increases for direct care staff and direct support professionals as defined by the Director of the New York State Office of the Aging.
