



Poets' Walk Park Trail Map

This 120-acre park offers relaxed walking in a beautiful landscape interspersed with benches, ornamental pavilions and sweeping Hudson River views. The entire trail system is about two and a quarter miles.



Parking Area to Overlook Pavilion (0.66 mile)

The trail leads through open fields artistically enclosed by woodland boundaries to create the impression of an unfolding series of outdoor "rooms." Scenic Hudson built the rustic Overlook Pavilion as an attractive place to rest and contemplate the landscape.



Overlook Pavilion to Summerhouse (.25 mile)

Beyond the pavilion, the trail forks. The right-hand branch leads along an old farm road through the woods, descending via two small bridges to the Summerhouse



Overlook Pavilion to Flagpole Lot (0.5 mile)

Turning left at the fork shortly beyond the Overlook Pavilion, the path descends gently past the base of an old flagpole to a stunning overlook featuring views of the Hudson, the Kingston-Rhinecliff Bridge and the Catskill Mountains. (Please do not attempt to cross the footbridge over the railroad tracks.)
