On Wednesday, October 11th at 7:00 p.m., County Executive Molinaro will present the Dutchess County Countywide Shared Services Tax Savings Plan, adopted and approved by all 30 local municipalities. The plan, submitted to the New York State Division of Budget last month, features 37 projects that collectively can provide over \$27 million in taxpayer savings in 2018 and 2019, if all projects are successfully implemented. County Executive Molinaro convened several meetings of the Shared Service Panel, comprised of local city, town and village executives, as well as representatives from several school districts and BOCES, to develop a plan as mandated by a provision of the 2017-18 New York State Budget. The plan features a broad spectrum of projects including shared salt and paving material purchasing, motor vehicle repair, website development and maintenance, shared court facilities and salt sheds, Drug Task Force efforts, municipal solar farms, consolidation of law enforcement, and much more. The projects range from two municipalities partnering together to county government-led projects with multiple local municipalities and school districts partnering in shared services efforts. The plan also includes a regional project with Dutchess and Ulster counties partnering to expand their Conflict Defender Swap program into Family Court, projected to save nearly \$70,000 over the two-year period.
