

RESOLUTION NO. 2024179

RE: AMENDING THE 2024 ADOPTED COUNTY BUDGET AS IT PERTAINS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY & FAMILY SERVICES (A.6055)

Legislators GARITO, POLASEK, GORMAN, D'AQUANNI, MC HOUL, and ROLISON offer the following and move its adoption:

WHEREAS, the Department of Community & Family Services (hereinafter "DCFS") administers a Childcare program each year which is reimbursed through the New York State Childcare Block Grant, and

WHEREAS, following changes made to the eligibility criteria as well as the outreach efforts to increase access to daycare services, DCFS has experienced a 52% increase in its caseload from 530 families reaching 1,004 children in January of 2023 to 807 families reaching 1,476 children as of October 1, 2024, and

WHEREAS, DCFS has advised that based upon this increase, the 2024 Childcare program expenses administered through DCFS will exceed the 2024 budget appropriations such that DCFS is requesting appropriations of \$2,000,000, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the 2024 Adopted County Budget to provide funds to cover the expenses of this valuable program for Dutchess County residents, now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Commissioner of Finance is authorized, empowered and directed to amend the 2024 Adopted County Budget as follows:

RE: Resolution request for additional appropriations for 2024 Childcare expenses.

The 2024 program expenses will exceed 2024 budget appropriations for the Childcare program administered through the Dutchess County Department of Community & Family Services. This program is 100% reimbursed through the New York State Childcare Block Grant.

Over the past year, following the changes made to the eligibility criteria as well as the outreach efforts to increase access to daycare services, we have experienced fifty-two (52%) increase in our caseload from 530 families reaching 1,004 children in January of 2023, to 807 families reaching 1,476 children as of October 1, 2024.

The Department of Community & Family Services is requesting the approval of the Dutchess County Legislature to add \$2,000,000 to cover expenses for this valuable program for Dutchess County residents.
