OFA ADDRESSES HOLIDAY LONELINESS

End-of-year holidays are upon us, bringing with them an expectation of thankfulness and togetherness; but for many of us, the expectation and the reality don't match up. OFA understands this through experience, and can offer an antidote to "the blahs" that works all year round: our "Friendly Calls" program.

"Friendly Calls" addresses social isolation and loneliness among older adults in Dutchess County with regularly scheduled calls from a caring, screened OFA volunteer. Our volunteers check in with participants for engaging conversations, once a week for eight weeks, with each call lasting between 20 and 30 minutes. If you've been thinking about volunteering but don't want to

overcommit yourself, "Friendly Calls" is an excellent option. Volunteers can connect with participants from home, on vacation, and anywhere their phone gets a good signal.

For volunteers and participants alike, it's a great way to speak to new people and get to know others. "Friendly Calls," since its inception, has paired hundreds of participants and volunteer callers, with feedback being overwhelmingly positive. Naturally Sweet Cranberry Sauce

Makes about 2 1/4 cups

Ingredients

1 12-oz bag cranberries (approx. 4 cups)

1/2 cup unsweetened applesauce

1 cup orange juice

1/3 cup agave syrup

1 cinnamon stick (or 1/2 teaspoon ground)

1/2 teaspoon allspice

1/4 teaspoon nutmeg

Directions	3

1.	Add cranberries, applesauce, orange juice and agave to a medium
	saucepan. Bring to a boil over medium heat.

- 2. Reduce to simmer and add cinnamon, allspice and nutmeg.
- 3. Let simmer for approximately 10-12 minutes or until most of the cranberries have burst.
- 4. Remove from heat and allow to cool completely.
