Executive Order No. 5 of 2014

I hereby issue the following Executive Order dedicating Dutchess County Route 7 (Beekman-Poughquag Road) to Kenneth Mallen of Beekman.

WHEREAS, the Town of Beekman adopted resolution 06:04:14-3(95) on June 4, 2014 requesting the County review and consider dedicating County Route 7 (Beekman-Poughquag Road) to Kenneth Mallen; and

WHEREAS, Kenneth Mallen is a decorated veteran having served in the United States Army during World War II where he was assigned to the Philippines receiving credit for four campaigns that earned him a Bronze Star and Philippines Liberation Medal; and


WHEREAS, Kenneth Mallen taught automotive mechanics at Green Haven Correctional Facility, served on the Town of Beekman Zoning Board of Appeals, and even now is a member of the Harlem Valley Masonic Lodge #358; and

WHEREAS, Kenneth Mallen added to his service to the community as a member of the Beekman Fire Company where he has served for over 75 years including 21 years as Fire Chief and for the last 44 years as Fire Commissioner; and

WHEREAS, Dutchess County Route 7 (Beekman-Poughquag Road) starts at the Beekman Town Hall and continues past the Beekman Fire Department ending at Beekman Road, it seems fitting and appropriate to dedicate this roadway to Kenneth Mallen; therefore, be it

ORDERED, that Dutchess County Route 7 (Beekman-Poughquag Road) located in the Town of Beekman is hereby dedicated to Kenneth Mallen.
