### EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 9 of 2021

**WHEREAS**, Sheriff Adrian “Butch” Anderson, who served as Sheriff of Dutchess County for 22 years, has died and calling hours will be held Tuesday October 5, 2021 from noon to 8 p.m. at the Majed J. Nesheiwat Convention Center, located at 14 Civic Center Plaza, in the City of Poughkeepsie, and funeral services are Wednesday October 6, 2021 at 10 a.m; and

**WHEREAS**, Sheriff Anderson’s extensive dedication and service to the community is expected to draw thousands of members of law enforcement, firefighters, first responders, dignitaries and community members to Poughkeepsie to pay tribute and honor his over 50 years of public service; and

**WHEREAS**, high volume vehicular and pedestrian traffic is expected for both Tuesday afternoon and evening viewing services, Wednesday funeral services, and road closures as well as parking facility closures will be in effect to give way to the procession and to those wishing to pay their respects; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 3.02 of the Dutchess County Charter provides that the County Executive shall be the Chief Executive Officer of the County and as such shall “supervise, and direct the internal structure and organization of every unit of the Executive Branch of the County government” and shall possess “all powers and duties necessarily implied or incidental thereto”; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Article 14 of the Dutchess County Charter, the Commissioner of Public Works, who serves at the pleasure of the County Executive, is responsible for the custodial care of all County buildings, parking fields, and other facilities with County jurisdiction; and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, to alleviate pedestrian and vehicular traffic congestion, to protect the safety and ensure more efficient travel of the public, and in anticipation of the thousands of bereaved who will come to pay their respects to Sheriff Anderson and his family, by the power vested in me as Chief Executive of Dutchess County, it is hereby

**ORDERED**, the following County Offices located in the City of Poughkeepsie will be closed commencing at 1 p.m. on Tuesday October 5, 2021 through Wednesday October 6, 2021 at 5 p.m.: 228 Main Street, 22 Market Street, 10 Market Street, 60 Market Street, 236 Main Street, 50 Market Street, 150 N. Hamilton Street, 108 Parker Avenue, 100 Parker Avenue, 168 Washington Street, 45 Market Street, 170 Washington Street, 112 Delafield Street, 114 Delafield Street, 85 Civic Center Plaza, 29 N Hamilton Street, and be it further

**ORDERED**, that parking facilities behind 22 Market Street and the County Office Building's Market Street visitor lot, both in Poughkeepsie, may be converted from general use and be reserved to accommodate service participants, commencing at 1 p.m. on Tuesday October 5, 2021 through Wednesday October 6, 2021 at 5 p.m.
