### EXECUTIVE ORDER 3 of 2017

WHEREAS, a winter storm and its effects have created conditions whereby the public safety is imperiled, and

WHEREAS, since the snow, wind and consequential conditions have rendered travel dangerous it is in the best interests of the citizens of Dutchess County that a local State of Emergency be declared with the imposition of restrictions on motor vehicle travel, and

WHEREAS, in conjunction with travel restrictions, it is in the best interests of the employees and residents of Dutchess County that County Offices and County public facilities be closed;

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the powers vested in me as County Executive by Article III of the Dutchess County Charter, Section 3.05(d) of the Administrative Code and pursuant to the provisions contained in Article 2-B of the New York State Executive Law,

IT IS DECLARED that a local State of Emergency exists throughout Dutchess County effective 4:30 AM of this 14<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2017.

The following restrictions are hereby imposed pursuant to Sections 24, Article 2-B of the Executive Law; Article III of the Dutchess County Charter and Section 3.05(d) of the Administrative Code: All County Offices and facilities are closed until further notice and travel on public road is restricted to emergency and essential traffic only.

IT IS FURTHER DECLARED this local State of Emergency shall remain in full force until rescinded.
