EXTENSION OF DECLARATION OF LOCAL EMERGENCY ORDER #2

EMERGENCY EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2 of 2020

WHEREAS, a State of Emergency was hereby declared in the County of Dutchess effective on March 13, 2020, by Emergency Executive Order No. 2 of 2020 due to a case of COVID-19 being confirmed in the County,

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020, Local Emergency Order #2 was declared pursuant to § 24 of the New York State Executive Law ordering:

SECTION 1. REGULATION OF PUBLIC GATHERINGS: All social, community, and public events or gatherings, including Dutchess County sponsored events, where it is anticipated that attendance will exceed twenty (20) people or more, shall be restricted, cancelled or postponed.

SECTION 2. PUNISHMENT:

Failure to obey this order is a criminal offense, punishable by law under New York State Executive Law § 24(5). In accordance with Executive Law Section 24(5), any person who knowingly violates the provisions of this order shall be guilty of a Class B Misdemeanor.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE:

I, Marcus J. Molinaro, the County Executive of Dutchess County, in accordance with a declaration of a State of Emergency issued on March 13, 2020 and pursuant to § 24(2) of the New York State Executive Law, do hereby order that the above local emergency order be extended from March 18, 2020 at 12am through March 22, 2020 at 11:59pm.

SECTION 4. DURATION.

This Order shall remain in effect until removed by the order of the County Executive and may also be renewed in five (5) day increments.
