The Clerk read the notice of public hearing regarding Proposed Change to LOOP Bus Fares for Dial-A-Ride Effective January 1, 2011.

The Chairman declared the public hearing open.

No one wishing to be heard, the Chairman declared the public hearing closed.

The Chairman entertained a motion from the floor, duly seconded and unanimously adopted, to suspend the Regular Order of Business to allow the public to address the Legislature on agenda items.

Constantine Kazolias, 47 Noxon Street, Poughkeepsie, New York spoke on the amount of the Fund Balance and how this would affect the County's bond rating.

RESOLUTION NO. 2010375

RE: SETTING LOOP BUS FARES FOR DIAL-A-RIDE

Legislators HUTCHINGS and ROLISON offer the following and move its adoption:

WHEREAS, Dutchess County Mass Transit operates both Dial-A-Ride, which is sponsored by various towns and the Dutchess County Office for the Aging, and Paratransit (Demand Response), which is sponsored by Dutchess County, and which is now to be known as Flex Service, and

WHEREAS, New York State Transit Operating Assistance (NYSTOA) regulations require passengers using such services pay a fare and the Dial-A-Ride fare is now discretionary, and

WHEREAS, to be eligible for NYSTOA for LOOP operations, which is currently projected to be \$1,695,050 for 2010, Dutchess County must establish a mandatory fare structure for Dial-A-Ride, and

WHEREAS, the Department of Planning and Development, Division of Mass Transit recommends the following Dial-A-Ride fares be set for the Dutchess County LOOP Bus Fares, effective January 1, 2011:

Dial-A-Ride Fare Category	Suggested Current Fare	Proposed Fare
Standard Fare	\$.75 - \$1.00 one way	\$3.50 one way
Senior Fare	\$.75 - \$1.00 one way	\$1.00 one way

No change is proposed for fixed route service fares or for Flex Service, and

WHEREAS, the standard fare for Flex Service is \$5.00 one way/one town and \$6.00 one way/two towns, and

WHEREAS, the proposed Dial-A-Ride fare is less than the standard fare for Flex Service because various towns and Dutchess County Office for the Aging sponsor Dial-A-Ride, and

WHEREAS, procedures established in accordance with U.S. Department of Transportation Regulations require a Public Hearing be held before any fare changes for LOOP bus service are implemented, and

WHEREAS, on December 16, 2010, this Legislature conducted a Public Hearing to receive public comments on a proposed change in LOOP bus fares for Dial-A-Ride to be effective January 1, 2011, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, effective January 1, 2011 bus fares for each rider category for Dial-A-Ride shall be as set as follows:

Dial-A-Ride Fare Category	Current or Suggested Fare	Proposed Fare
Standard Fare	\$.75 - \$1.00 one way	\$3.50 one way
Senior Fare	\$.75 - \$1.00 one way	\$1.00 one way

No change is proposed for fixed route service fares or for Flex Services, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Dutchess County Department of Planning & Development shall cause such fare structure to be implemented effective January 1, 2011.
