Whereas, the Dutchess County Legislature has learned with sadness and regret of the recent death of Frederick Scoralick on November 29, 2015, at the age of 80, and

Whereas, Fred was born on August 16, 1935, in Poughkeepsie, New York, and was the youngest of three children born to the late Mary Irene Brennan Scoralick and Fred Scoralick, he was born and raised on his family farm in Poughquag and attended local schools graduating from Arlington High School in 1954, and

Whereas, Fred ran the Scoralick Family Farm for more than a decade in the 50's and 60's before becoming a business manager for Clove Excavators, and he was a volunteer fireman with the Beekman Fire Department where he held multiple offices, and later became involved with the Town of Union Vale where he served on the Planning Board, as well as two terms as Town Councilman, and

Whereas, in 1961 Fred was appointed as a part-time Deputy to the Dutchess County Sheriff's Office, and for 17 years he worked in the local communities doing general police activities, and in 1976 Fred was appointed as UnderSheriff of Dutchess County, and in 1978 Fred was elected the Dutchess County Sheriff and was re-elected 5 more times to serve as Sheriff where during his tenure, Sheriff Scoralick steadily increased services to the community and implemented various programs including youth support and D.A.R.E., Crash Management, Arson Investigation, County Wide Drug Task Force, and the Senior Citizen "Are You OK?" Service, and after serving 21 years as elected Sheriff and 17 additional years with the Sheriff's Office, Fred retired in 1999, and at that time he was the longest serving elected Sheriff in Dutchess County history, and

Whereas, Fred served as Chairman of the Executive Committee of the New York State Sheriffs' Association and held every office including President of that organization, and in 1987 he was elected to the National Sheriffs' Association's Board of Directors and ultimately served as President of the NSA from 1997-1998, and

Whereas, after retirement he served as a member of the Union Vale Republican Committee and the Dutchess County Agricultural Society, and

Whereas, his passing will be mourned by his family, friends, and colleagues throughout Dutchess County, now, therefore, be it


