Legislator Pulver was elected Chair of the Legislature

Chair Pulver read the following address:

*Thank you all.*

*I hope that each time I stand before you as a candidate for this position of Chairman, I'm more seasoned leader, a wiser counselor and steadier hand.*

*This is now the fourth time I've been elected Chairman of the legislature, and I hope that is evidence of my personal growth and the growth of this body. Outside of these chambers over the past year, the role the legislator*

*has taken on new meaning. It's meant grocery shopping for seniors, picking up medicine for them at the pharmacy, participating in drive by birthday parties and graduations, and helping relatives who aren't so good with Zoom, now that we host our meetings on the platform. We've had to offer assistance and advice to individuals and businesses as they navigate new federal and state public health guidelines. Being a local representative, we are most in touch with our communities and many look to us for answers, compassion, and a sympathetic ear, which I think most of us did in April.*

*Outside our building, a nurse stands tall and proud on Market Street. So many health care workers have put themselves at great risk this past year to give aid to our most sick. While we lost too many people in 2020, I hope we can take a small piece of comfort in knowing that in Dutchess, our health care workers were by their side offering the best care possible, comfort and peace.*

*And thank you all who contributed towards the safety, the continuation of the betterment of our society. To the logistic workers who made sure that our grocery store received every roll of toilet paper and Lysol wipes we could get on the shelves, and to the shelf stacker who placed them there. To those who chose to gather around an outdoor fire pit instead of a kitchen table this holiday season, so many have done so much, and I hope we all find the strength to continue.*

*In November, the voters of this county overwhelmingly passed a referendum to the county charter to implement a new independent reapportionment committee. We are now the second county in the state to have such a structure. I would like to remind everyone to remove themselves from this process. The new map cannot and should not be influenced by partisan preference or individual politicians. I think we have proven up to the task performing this body for the better. Reapportionment, term limits, and ethics reform mean that we operate under the trifecta of good government. And further restructuring of the legislature may be up for discussion this year as downsizing and other changes would provide more streamlined and efficient government for the people.*

*In 2021, this body will continue our hard work and we will always carefully consider the impactful decisions we are confronted with. So much of our work happens outside these chambers, ideas are developed, discussions are had, and we'll keep striving to find ways to make lives better for each resident of this county.*

*Two years ago, I stood before you and acknowledged the reality of an election year. I once again ask us all to keep the political theatrics and keep campaign publicity stunts out of this body.*

*As a legislator, our chief goal should be to achieve, not to achieve re-election, but to make this county a better place for all.*

*We were asking a lot of our county employees this year, and I think it's only fair to ask a lot from each of you as well. Thank you to each of the fifteen members who so humbly agreed to donate your salary increase this year to*

*charity.*

*This body, you as legislators, have been given enormous opportunities to impact the lives of 300,000 people and thousands of businesses. Let us all work diligently in this new year together.*

*And I close with, let's go Yankees.*

*Thank you.*
