(SUPERCEDING RESOLUTION NO. 2011244)

Legislators HUTCHINGS and FLESLAND offer the following and move its adoption:

WHEREAS, a Project for the Dutchess Rail Trail: Old Manchester Road – Overocker Road (Stage 4), Towns of LaGrange and Poughkeepsie, Dutchess County, PIN 8760.26 (the “Project”) is eligible for funding under Title 23, U.S. Code, as amended, that calls for the apportionment of the costs of such program to be borne at the ratio of 80% Federal funds and 20% non-federal funds, and

WHEREAS, Dutchess County desires to advance the Project by making a commitment of 100% of the non-federal share of the costs of construction, construction inspection and construction supervision, and

WHEREAS, this Legislature adopted Resolution No. 2011244 in connection with this matter on November 9, 2011 and said Resolution is being superseded by this Resolution, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the 2011 Adopted County Budget to provide funds to meet the County’s obligation for the aforesaid project, now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that Resolution No. 2011244 adopted on November 9, 2011 is hereby superseded by this resolution, and

RESOLVED, that the Dutchess County Legislature hereby approves of the above subject Project, and it is further

RESOLVED, that the Dutchess County Legislature hereby authorizes the County of Dutchess to pay in the first instance 100% of the federal and non-federal share of the cost of construction, construction inspection and construction supervision work for the Project or portions thereof, and it is further

RESOLVED, that the sum of \$7,410,000 is hereby appropriated and made available to cover the cost of participation in the above phase of the Project, and it is further

RESOLVED, that in the event the full federal and non-federal share costs of the Project exceeds the amount appropriated above, the Dutchess County Legislature shall convene as soon as possible to appropriate said excess amount immediately upon the notification by the Commissioner of Public Works thereof, and it is further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive be and he hereby is authorized to execute all necessary agreements, certifications or reimbursement requests for Federal Aid

and/or applicable Marchiselli Aid with the New York State Department of Transportation on behalf of the County of Dutchess in connection with the advancement or approval of the above referenced Project and providing for the administration of the Project and the municipality's first instance funding of Project costs and permanent funding of the local share of federal-aid and state-aid eligible Project costs and all Project costs within appropriations therefore that are not so eligible, and it is further

RESOLVED, that a certified copy of this resolution be filed with the New York State Commissioner of Transportation by attaching it to any necessary agreement in connection with the Project, and it is further

RESOLVED, that this resolution shall take effect immediately, and it is further

RESOLVED, that the Commissioner of Finance is authorized, empowered and directed to amend the 2011 Adopted County Budget as follows:

Re: Resolution Number 2011313, Adoption of the 2012 Tentative Budget for Dutchess County

Leading up to and during this year's legislative budget process, my 20th and final budget preparation as County Executive, I have been pleased with the Legislature's approach to its review of the 2012 Tentative Budget. I would like to thank all legislators, and especially commend Dale Borchert, Chairman of Budget and Finance, for his level of professionalism and respect that is much appreciated by all the departmental and executive staff who are direct participants in the review process. This approach is absolutely necessary if there is to be a productive and workable result.

I also appreciate the Legislature's overall endorsement of the Executive budget I submitted for your consideration. I welcome your support of the administration's property tax cap, as well as your embrace of the various reforms I have proposed that add to those I have offered and you have supported in prior years.

The Legislature has made relatively few changes to the budget when one considers its size and scope. Extremely difficult for all of us are the decisions to restructure and downsize county government, eliminating positions that cause layoffs of dedicated and hardworking county staff.

After thorough review of the Legislature's adopted budget and for reasoning explained below, I wish to address just two legislative line item changes to the Executive budget. Other amendments that concern me I will allow to remain as modified.

National, state and local unemployment numbers have been at longtime highs for an extended period and impact many of our neighbors and even family members. In Dutchess, unemployment rates ranging from 7% up to almost 9% have been the norm for three years, as compared to rates below 4% just five years ago – leaving nearly 10,000 unemployed and many thousands more underemployed.

Foreclosure rates in Dutchess County, again our neighbors and friends suffering the anguish and stress of losing their homes, are at record numbers. There are a total of over 4,000 foreclosures in Dutchess over just the last three year period.

The dramatic caseload increases in Temporary Assistance, Medicaid, food stamps, aging and public health services, among others, that we see in county government services paint a painful picture for all of us: **the economic pressures felt by too many residents continue to worsen.**

On principle, therefore, I hope you can understand why I cannot support quick or arbitrary decisions regarding two selected salary raises granted out of 1900 county employees. There is no evidence offered that is so extremely compelling for me to support these two large salary increases in this economic environment.

Specific to our organization, the county has **long-established salary procedures, practices, and policies.** Specifically the changes adopted by the Legislature would provide salary increases for two positions; the County Legislature's part time Attorney and the Sheriff's top administrator at the Jail, increases of approximately 24% and 18% respectively. These salary policies are in place to avoid not only the appearance of arbitrary decisions or political favoritism, but also to prevent selective application.

In addition, we currently have three union bargaining units, or the majority of the county's 1900 plus employees, without contracts and in varying stages of negotiation, with no CPI or COLA wage increases being provided since these agreements expired. This is the third year where the entire group of 208 management and confidential employees will receive no salary increase.

I do not believe it is the intent of any of you to send the wrong message to highway workers, 911 dispatchers, DSS caseworkers, correction officers, or all our other hardworking and loyal employees that there are two preferential positions in county government somehow worthy of circumventing longstanding salary policies. But unfortunately that's exactly what you would be doing.

For the record, it's important you understand my reasoning is not based on individuals or the work they do; it is based upon maintaining the fairness and equity across our existing structure. I am hopeful the Legislature will appreciate the negative impact on overall employee morale, as well as the negative negotiating environment these two changes would cause.

Therefore, the following two line item changes are disapproved and vetoed:

A1010.1010 #1407, an increase of \$8,830 in Positions (Part time Legislative Attorney)

A3150.1010 #1269, an increase of \$15,252 in Positions (Cor Lt Colonel, Jail Administrator)

Finally, I wish the 2012 Dutchess County Legislature and incoming County Executive-elect Molinaro and his administration much success next year and beyond.

Dear Ms. Horn:

I am writing in response to your letter of November 5, 1992 expressing concern regarding efforts by Iroquois Gas Transmission Systems, Inc. President Robert Reid to intimidate landowners. We have reviewed the Iroquois letter very carefully and we share your concern about its possible effect on landowners. We do not believe, however, that it rises to a level where an injunction or other legal steps are warranted. Our conclusion in this regard may change should we learn of a pattern of such conduct or other efforts directed at landowners.

We have taken immediate steps to contact counsel for Iroquois and advise them of the serious criminal statutes which are violated by efforts to intimidate or mislead prospective witnesses. A copy of this letter is enclosed for your information. We will continue to monitor this situation very closely and would appreciate hearing from you again if any new information of a similar nature comes to light.

Thank you very much for your correspondence in this regard.

RE: Iroquois Gas Transmission System Investigation

Dear George:

This office has recently received a substantial number of complaints from landowners and/or their legal and elected representatives regarding a letter sent by Iroquois President Robert Reid addressing the U.S. Attorney's criminal investigation. A copy of this letter is attached. The complainants have expressed concern that Iroquois is attempting to mislead and intimidate landowners.

As you know, 18 U.S.C. § 1512 provides for criminal penalties for anyone who:

knowingly uses intimidation or physical force, threatens, or corruptly persuades another person, or attempts to do so, or engages in misleading conduct toward another person with intent to:

(1) influence, delay, or prevent the testimony of any person in any official proceeding;

(2) cause or induce any person to:

(a) Withhold testimony, or withhold a record, document or other object, from an official proceeding....

The complaining parties have been particularly concerned with the last full paragraph of Mr. Reid's letter which states in part that "...this will better prepare our attorneys for their cross-



examination of you, and as a result your trial testimony should be easier and briefer." This portion of the letter is arguably intimidating and misleading since, at least at the present time, there has been no determination that individuals who provide information to the Government will be subject to trial testimony or even that a trial will occur.

No further action is contemplated by our office at this time in connection with Mr. Reid's letter. However, we felt it necessary to bring these complaints to your attention and for whatever action you deemed appropriate.
