Clerk read notice of public hearing.

The Chairman declared the public hearing open.

Tim Collopy, Millbrook, questioned how it was possible to have a budget with no reduction in services, services being added, a 10% property tax cut, and the elimination of sales tax with no increase in debt. He further questioned what portion of the projected revenue for the proposed budget was from state and federal funding.

Barbara Walsh, Hopewell Junction, questioned spending American Rescue Fund money on Dutchess Stadium and if the County Executive received political donations from those the county had contracts with.

Legislator Truitt called point of order because Ms. Walsh's statement did not pertain to the proposed 2022 county budget.

Chairman Pulver ruled that Ms. Walsh's statements did not pertain to the proposed 2022 county budget.

Legislator Atkins spoke in support of allowing the public to speak.

Legislator Truitt called point of order to Legislator Atkins for speaking out of line.

Erin Cannan, Red Hook, spoke in favor of additional funding for the Board of Elections NYS required voter action plan and for youth voter education programs throughout Dutchess County school districts.

Jonathan Becker, Town of Red Hook, spoke in favor of funding for the Board of Elections to survey sites for ADA handicap accessibility and compliancy.

There being no one else wishing to speak, the Chairman declared the public hearing closed.

The public hearing was adjourned at 7:06 pm.
