RE: RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 200259, CREATING TASK FORCE TO STUDY TICK CONTROL AND LYME DISEASE PREVENTION IN DUTCHESS COUNTY

Legislators BOLNER, TRAUDT, KELSEY, FLESLAND, and WEISS offer the following and move its adoption:

WHEREAS, the Dutchess County Legislature is committed to efforts in controlling the tick population, and

WHEREAS, by resolution No. 258, the Legislature has authorized to contract with the Cary Institute for Ecosystem Studies to continue its research into tick ecology, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to develop long-term goals in Dutchess County regarding the control of tick populations, and

WHEREAS, said long-term goals can only be developed through the use of professionals and other persons knowledgeable with respect to the diseases transmitted by ticks, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Dutchess County Legislature does hereby create a Task Force to coordinate efforts to understand and reduce the population of ticks and to prevent Lyme Disease and other tick borne disease, the members of which are to be appointed by the Chairman of the Legislature, and which members shall be comprised of professionals and those knowledgeable in the field, and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the mission of said task force is to develop long-term goals and make recommendations to this Legislature in the efforts of understanding and safely controlling ticks and reducing Lyme Disease and other tick borne diseases.


