# QA screening and Assessment

- The number of individuals screened for the RESTART program
- The number and percentage of individuals with a high level of criminogenic risk
- The number and percentage of individuals with a medium level criminogenic of risk
- The number and percentage of RESTART participants who receive a COMPAS assessment with related Service and Discharge plans (target: 100%)

# QA In-Jail Programming

- The number of RESTART housing unit beds that are occupied by individuals actively participating in group treatment
- RESTART will track the number and percentage of participants who complete 6 or more weeks of programming
- Participants will receive a minimum 10 units of group treatment per week (unit = 60 minutes)
- The number of RESTART participants with Proxy scores in 4-6 range will be tracked.

# Post Release Measures:

- The number of participants who keep a post release service appointment
- The number of participants who engage in core community services and satisfactorily complete post release programming
- RESTART participants who complete in-jail services will recidivate at a rate 10% less than a comparative sample of DCJ inmates who did not participate in RESTART

# Post Release Measures:

- The number of participants with identified psychiatric issues who are released with a symptom management plan
- The number of participants with identified educational deficits who are released with a plan to address education needs post release
- The number of participants who are work-ready at time of jail release who are employed or actively seeking employment
