AMENDING LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF 2024 REGULATING HAZARDOUS
POLLUTION SOURCES IN PROXIMITY TO PUBLIC WATER SUPPLY
SOURCES, AQUIFERS AND WETLANDS

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF THE COUNTY OF DUTCHESS,
STATE OF NEW YORK AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Local Law No. 2 of 2024 Section 3: Prohibited Conduct, Subsection A. Dutchess
County Local Separation Requirements, page 4, 4th listed item which currently reads as follows:

“Commercial car wash unless all waste waters from such activity
are lawfully disposed through a connection to a publicly owned
treatment works facility”

Shall be amended to read as follows:

“Commercial car wash unless all waste waters from such activity
are lawfully disposed through a connection to a publicly owned
treatment works facility or unless all waters from such activity are
recycled through a closed loop water reclaim system with zero
discharge to surface or ground waters”

SECTION 2. SEQRA DETERMINATION


It is hereby determined, pursuant to the provisions of the State Environmental Quality Review Act, 8 NYECL Section 8-0101 et seq., and its implementing regulations, 6 NYCRR Section 617, that the adoption of this local law is an Unlisted Action within the meaning of 6 NYCRR Section 617.2(al). Attached hereto and made a part hereof is a Full Environmental Assessment Form developed by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation and completed by the County of Dutchess, which assesses the potential for adverse environmental impact which may be posed by the adoption of this local law. As documented in its Full Environmental Assessment Form, it is hereby determined that the adoption of this local law poses no significant adverse environmental impacts.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Local Law shall take effect upon filing in the Office of the Secretary of State.
