Children & Youth Amanda Dixon	 The group met and discussed the following: Alice reported for the group and shared that they are continuing to work to create a pamphlet on Dutchess County supports and services for providers and families in the community, using the NYS document as a guide, but being mindful to include referral information for these services. They have been discussing resources for very early interventions for parents who are at risk of abuse and neglect. Interventions would hopefully prevent some big issues down the line and might include teaching parenting skills and showing parents how to foster a good relationship with their baby etc. There are some similar models within DCFS & Early Intervention, but nothing quite like what the group was discussing. They're going to investigate it further.
