

SELECTION CRITERIA

Applicants will be selected on the basis of three major criteria: innovation and potential for success of a proposed personal focus/project that the student will complete during their PHIL experience, the student's predicted suitability to the PHIL program and in the larger Department of Behavioral & Community Health system, and a track record of commitment to projects and interests.

Please be advised that selected applicants who will have direct client contact will be required to successfully complete fingerprinting and background checks prior to engaging in contact with clients. A \$25 money order made out to NYS Office of Children and Family Services must be provided for these services by the student or their institution. Fingerprinting and background checks must be completed one month prior to beginning a clinical placement. A resume and copy of your driver's license will also be needed for selected applicants.

All attached supporting documentation must be saved as a pdf and titled by your last name, first initial and document title. Only complete applications will be considered.
