

PHIL+ Tracks

Advanced Graduate-level placements

(Minimum time commitment: 14 hours per week for 1 seasonal semester or as otherwise determined)

Advanced Mental Wellness track:

- Student will be placed in intensive mental wellness treatment program
- Suggested study areas: Graduate-level Psychology, Social Work, or Mental Health Counseling
- Duties may include: Individual counseling, group facilitation, assisting with program projects, topic-based trainings, shadowing clinical staff, research, community needs assessments, curriculum development

Advanced Substance Recovery track:

- Students will be placed in intensive substance use recovery program
- Suggested study areas: Graduate-level Psychology, Social Work, or Mental Health Counseling
- Duties may include: Individual counseling, group facilitation, assisting with program projects, topic-based trainings, shadowing clinical staff, research, community needs assessments, curriculum development

Advanced Educational Development & Training track:

- Student will be placed in Coordinated Services division
- Suggested study areas: Graduate-level Education/Pedagogy, Public Health, English/Liberal Arts, Humanities
- Duties may include: public health topic-specific training curriculum development, training implementation, training assessments and feedback incorporation, development of topic-specific tip sheets, virtual resource library, training-specific needs assessment in the community, training request management

Advanced Forensic track:

- Student will be placed in Forensic Services division
- Suggested study areas: Graduate-level Psychology, Social Work, or Mental Health Counseling
- Duties may include: shadowing staff conducting forensic evaluations, conducting forensic evaluations under supervision, exploring topic-specific research, project-based work, report writing and developing, interdisciplinary collaboration

Forensic Pathology track:

- Student will be placed in the Medical Examiner's Office
- Suggested study areas: Physician Assistant, Nurse Practitioner, Physical Therapy
- Duties may include: shadowing and assisting staff in death investigations and autopsies, data collection and analysis, project-based work

Nursing track:

- Student will be placed in Disease Prevention division or other applicable program
- Suggested study areas: Nursing

- Duties may include: nursing related duties, shadowing, community response, needs assessments, health related programming and training, skill development, project-based work, assessments, material development and distribution
