

Dutchess County Department of Emergency Response GIS Data Request

Any agency that makes a request for GIS Data from the Department of Emergency Response is required to first complete and submit the attached GIS Data Request form.

As stated on the form, you are acknowledging that the County of Dutchess provides this data “as-is”, and holds no liability arising from any incomplete, incorrect, inaccurate or misleading data. In addition, the requester will have no claims to data updates.

It should also be understood that this data is not “owned” solely by the Department of Emergency Response. Therefore, all primary dataset editors will be contacted by the Department of Emergency Response for their authorization to release the requested data to you. On occasions, the data release request may be temporarily denied if the editor is in the middle of an edit session. You will be contacted if any of the datasets are not available at the time of your request.

The following datasets are available:

Roads / Internal Roads – Identifies the public & private roadways in Dutchess County, and is designed primarily for 911 addressing use. This dataset is not designed for “routable” use. Those agencies who are looking for a file to use for routing purposes should explore the <http://www.nysgis.state.ny.us/> website.

Address Points – A point exists for every unique address in Dutchess County, with some additional locations. Address points are typically placed directly on the location of the actual structure. The address point file was developed primarily for E911 use, and many “CAD points” have been developed within the address point file to identify specific locations which may not be an actual address, but are for E911 use.

Municipalities – This data layer defines the geographical boundaries between Dutchess County municipalities. Towns, Villages, and Cities are outlined.

Parcels – This dataset defines the tax parcel boundaries for all municipalities in Dutchess County.

Named Areas – This polygon feature class represents official and non-official designations of geographic areas that have a name associated with them. These polygons' extent can cover single parcel or multi-parcel areas and include such areas as apartments, condos, developments, estates, farms, group homes, medical facilities, parks, schools, trailer parks and other areas that Emergency Response may need to see as part of their E911 dispatch operations.

Structures - Polygon representation of structure rooflines that are over 400 sq. ft. Only structures in existence on the 2004 Aerial photographs are currently included.

Building Footprints – Used to identify most lot numbers within trailer parks, apartment complexes and colleges throughout Dutchess County.

DC_Trails – A line dataset to identify many of the trail systems in Dutchess County.

Water Bodies – Identifies lakes, ponds and streams throughout the county.

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All GIS data requests are processed in the order received, and may require up to ten business days to complete after receipt by Dutchess County Department of Emergency Response. We will contact you to review and verify your request.

- 2) County of Dutchess makes no warranties of the fitness or merchantability either express or implied in regard to the data provided to the Requester hereunder. The data provided is provided "as is".
- 3) The Requester will have no claims to data updates.
- 4) The Requester shall indemnify and hold harmless the County of Dutchess and its officers, employees and agents from and against all losses, claims, demands, actions payments, costs, suits, liabilities, including attorney's fees, expenses and damages (direct or consequential) whether or not caused by the negligence of the County, its officers, employees, or agents, which are incurred by or recovered against the County for any reason whatsoever arising out of or relating to release of the data, or to any use to which the Requester might use the data.
- 5) Dutchess County will not act or serve as a consultant to the requester after delivery of the data. This data is developed primarily for Dutchess County's internal use, and projected to: NAD_1983_StatePlane_New_York_East_FIPS_3101_Feet. The County of Dutchess will not explain how to convert this data to any special needs or alternate coordinate projections.
