The following Rules and Regulation regarding Local Law 11 of 1983 as Amended and Extended will be in place during the State of Emergency.

The Commissioner of Finance is adopting the amended rules and regulations at the direction of the County Executive and pursuant to her authority under Local Law 11 of 1983, as amended and extended.

Local Law 11 grants the Commissioner of Finance the authority to ^u make, adopt and amend rules and regulations appropriate to the carrying out of this local law and the purpose therefore".

Hotel tax payments may be made during the period of the State of Emergency declared by the NYS Governor and/or the County Executive of the County of Dutchess but are not compulsory. Hotel, Bed & Breakfasts and short- term rentals must continue to file their hotel tax returns.

Third party vendors collecting hotel tax on behalf of short-term rentals should continue to remit the hotel tax with their tax returns.

Upon the end of the State of Emergency, the Commissioner of Finance will entertain payment plans. The Commissioner of Finance reserves the exclusive right to set the terms of any payment plan.
