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**Criteria for Veterans' Credit** (5 points for an open competitive exam or 2.5 points for a promotion exam):

1. Be a U.S. citizen or an alien lawfully admitted for permanent residence at the time of application and examination.
2. Must be a resident of New York State at time of application for examination.
3. Have received an honorable discharge or been released under honorable conditions.
4. Have served during "war time" or other service as defined as follows:
  - World War II, from December 7, 1941 to December 31, 1946
  - Korean Conflict, from June 27, 1950 to January 31, 1955
  - Vietnam Conflict, from February 28, 1961 to May 7, 1975
  - Lebanon, from June 1, 1983 to December 1, 1987, being awarded an expeditionary medal
  - Grenada, from October 23, 1983 to November 21, 1983, being awarded an expeditionary medal
  - Panama, from December 20, 1989 to January 31, 1990, being awarded an expeditionary medal
  - Persian Gulf Conflict, from August 2, 1990 to "end of such hostilities"
  - US Public Health Service, from June 29, 1945 to December 31, 1946, or from June 26, 1950 to July 3, 1952

**Criteria for Disabled Veterans' Credit** (additional 5 points for a total of 10 points for an open competitive exam or 2.5 points for a total of 5 points for a promotion exam):

1. Disabled in the actual performance of duty during "wartime" as described above.
2. Currently receiving payments from the Veterans' Administration for such disability, which is rated at 10% or more.

**For candidates still in service at time of examination:** Proof of active service (military ID card, military orders, or other official military document) must be submitted at time of application. Actual credit points will not be added to a candidate's grade until the submission of this application and DD214 upon discharge.
