

LIST OF ACCEPTABLE ITEMS MAILED TO FACILITY OR DROPPED OFF

In addition to general mail delivered to the facility, the following items are also accepted:

(Revised and in effect as of August 13, 2025. All previous editions are obsolete.)

1. LEGAL PAPERWORK

2. BOOKS

Books must be sent directly from an online publisher or bookstore. (i.e., amazon.com or bn.com) Used or hardcover books will not be accepted.

3. CLOTHING

Clothing for trial appearances and funeral visits are the only clothing accepted at this facility. It is recommended that said clothing be dropped off in person for immediate inspection and approval. Clothing may not be blue or black in color or resemble an officer's uniform in any way.

4. PICTURES

Photographs cannot be suggestive, provocative, nude, or revealing in nature. The photographs cannot be larger than 5x7 or a polaroid, or with a frame.

5. BRASSIERE(S)

Brassieres are the only underwear that will be allowed to be mailed into the facility. It must be shipped directly from a verifiable online source to the jail. (i.e., Kohls.com, Macys.com, etc.) The brassiere will not be accepted if it contains any padding, underwire, hidden pockets, or metal. (Only metal in clasp will be allowed)

6. MEDICAL APPLIANCES

Currently, the medical department will only accept: Eyeglasses, C-PAP machine, and diabetic socks. These items must be dropped off in person and will be subject to inspection and approval from jail staff.

7. RELIGIOUS ARTICLES:

The only religious items that are allowed within this facility are rosary beads, religious medals, prayer rugs and religious headwear. The following restrictions apply to these religious articles:

- Religious Prayer Rugs - There shall not be any tassels or jewelry attached to the prayer rug. The prayer rug cannot exceed 27" x 43" (70 x 110 cm) in size.
- Rosary beads can only be made of plastic and be black, brown, or white in color.
- Religious medals cannot be larger than two (2") inches and cannot have any stones, sharp edges or ornaments in them. Religious medallions must represent the same denomination as listed religious preference.
- Religious headwear must be the proper headwear of that particular religion.

There is a maximum limit of one (1) religious item that can be in the possession of the incarcerated individual. All other religious items will remain in the incarcerated individual's property.

Items that can be purchased in commissary or that is issued by the facility

are not allowed to be mailed in and will be returned to the sender.
