

## Trails at Wilcox Park

The trail system at Wilcox Park is comprised of about 6 miles of marked trails. These trails wander through the 600-acre park including fields, forests, streams, and views of the Catskill Mountains. The trails are open to walkers, hikers, runners, and leashed dogs. The trail surface is natural and can be rocky in some spots. Please be careful while using the trails. It is always a good idea to go with at least one other person.

There is a large diversity of native plants and wildlife that inhabit the park. Ticks and poison ivy are also present so be aware of where you walk and always check for ticks after exiting the trails.

The staff of Wilcox Park work to keep the trails suitable for use, but storms and other natural events sometimes leave the trails with obstacles and challenges that you will encounter before we do. Please report any problems you see on the trails to the main office.

**Please check park closing time before starting on a trail. Allow sufficient time to exit the park before it closes.**



## Wilcox Park Rules:

- Park opens at 8 a.m., April – December.
- Park opens at 9 a.m., January – March.  
(Closing time changes seasonally)
- Dogs must be leashed.
- Clean up after your pet.
- Do not litter.
- Do not remove or disturb natural or cultural resources.
- No fires except in grills.
- No alcohol without a permit.
- No bikes on trails.
- Horseback riding is prohibited.
