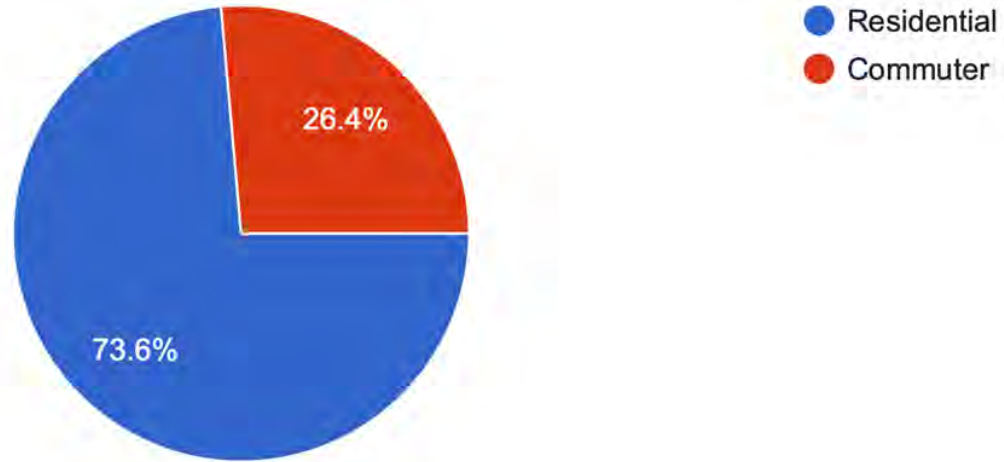

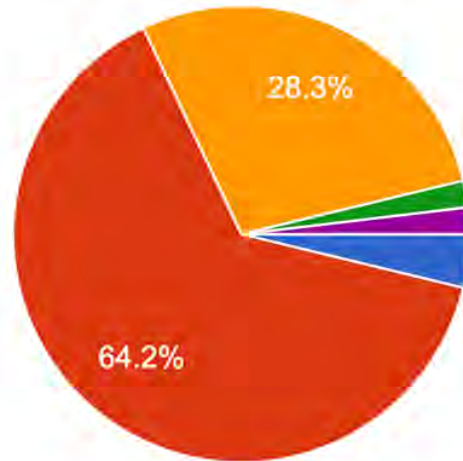
Are you a residential or commuter student at Marist?

53 responses



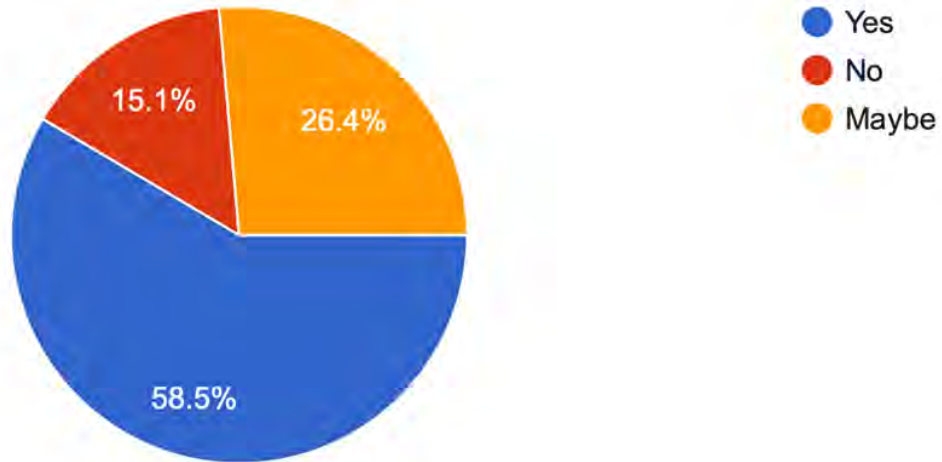
- Satisfied
