Subject: Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) Call for Projects

I am excited to announce that the [Dutchess County Transportation Council \(DCTC\)](#) is accepting applications for transportation safety projects consistent with our recently adopted [Transportation Safety Action Plan](#).

Applications may be submitted by public entities seeking funding to complete transportation safety projects in their communities or for facilities under their jurisdiction. For projects on State highways or County roads, local municipalities should first reach out to NYSDOT Region 8 or County Public Works, respectively, to discuss project proposals.

A total of \$2.5 million in federal funding is available to Dutchess County communities. Funding for this call comes from the federal Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP). Federal funds will cover up to 80 percent of the total project cost, with the remaining 20 percent covered by local funds.
