Dear Interested Party:

The three Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs) of the Mid-Hudson Valley
Transportation Management Area (TMA) – the <u>Dutchess County Transportation Council</u>, <u>Orange County Transportation Council</u>, and <u>Ulster County Transportation Council</u> – are excited to announce a competitive call for transit projects in the Mid-Hudson Valley. Over \$13 million in <u>Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5307 funds</u> are available to support a mix of transit activities related to capital purchases, facility upgrades, and passenger related improvements in Dutchess, Orange, and Ulster counties. These federal funds have been apportioned to our area based on population and transit operating statistics.

The MPOs, with assistance from the New York State Department of Transportation, will evaluate proposals based on the project selection criteria included with the application packet. In general, we seek to support transit projects that meet one or more of the following objectives:

- Maintain existing transit services and promote a state of good repair.
- Improve the safety and security of transit passengers and workers.
- Promote the use of technology to improve operations and passenger experiences.
- Improve access between transit systems and other modes such as walking and biking.
- Support local land use, economic development, and climate resiliency goals.
- Implement recommendations from <u>Connect Mid-Hudson</u>, the regional transit plan, such as improving intermodal connections.

Proposals must first meet the initial screening criteria established for this program, including identifying a Designated Recipient to receive and process FTA funds (a list of Designated Recipients is included with the application packet). Eligible proposals are limited to projects that can be implemented in one to three years, as the available funds will expire. All applications will be reviewed by staff for initial eligibility and completeness, after which projects will be rated by a TMA review committee using the included evaluation criteria.

Applicants may download the application and selection criteria from their respective MPO's website.
