2.a Draft Federal Certification Review Report

- Done every four years by FHWA and FTA for large urban areas
- Assesses how we're carrying out the planning process, individually as an MPO and collectively as a TMA
- Findings:
 - No corrective actions
 - Several recommendations and commendations
 - DCTC commended for Resilient Ways Forward
 - Notable practices highlighted

Announcements

2.b NYS Thruway Safety Action Plan

- Using the Safe Systems Approach to identify and prioritize safety improvements across the entire Thruway (570 miles)
 - Similar to our Safety Action Plan
- Asking for feedback on safety issues and concerns
 - Interactive map, comment box, & plan newsletter

2.c Funding Opportunities

- TAP
 - Funding (single project): \$500,000 - \$7M
 - Mandatory pre-review was due January 15, 2026
 - Applications due March 12, 2026

- BUILD
 - Funding: Max award of \$25M. Min. \$1M for rural and \$5M for urban
 - Applications were due February 24, 2026

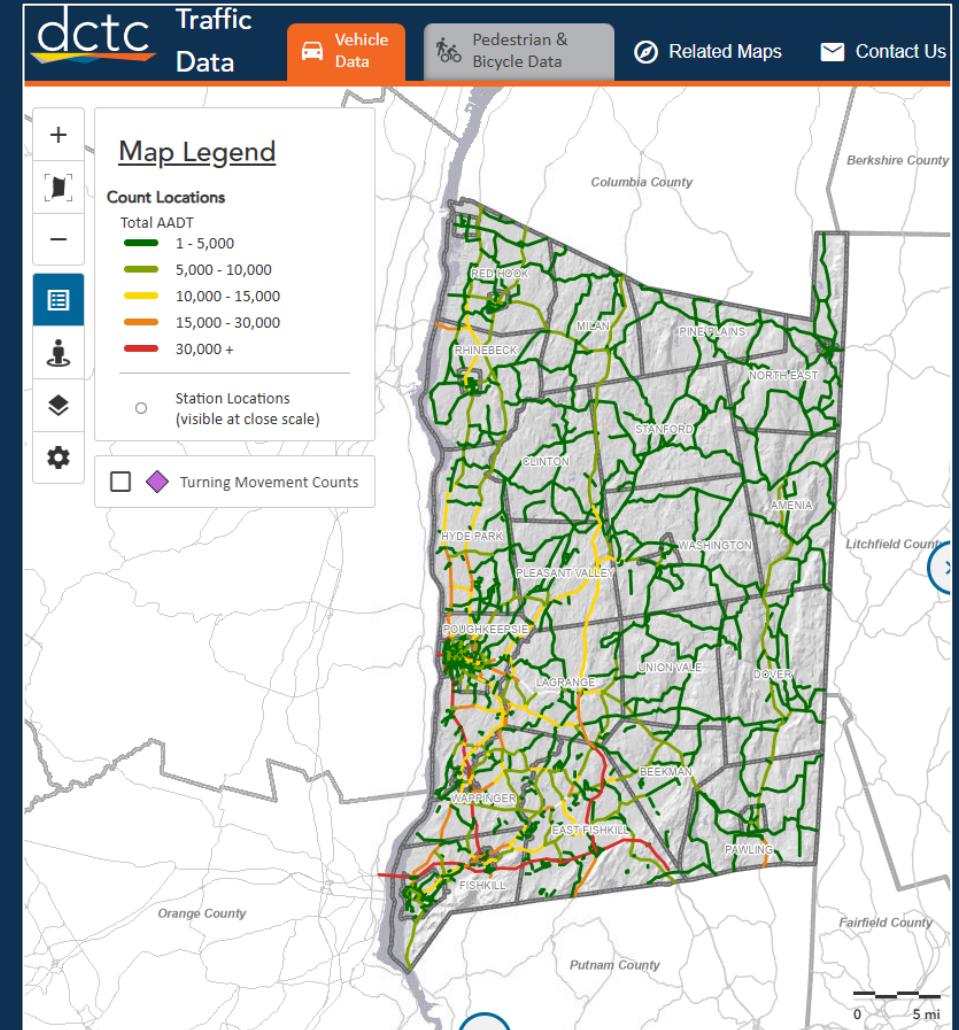
6.d City of Beacon Sidewalk Inventory
