  - New FFY 2026 project; \$15.5M total project cost
- 8TD031 Purchase 15 Heavy Duty Buses for DCPT
  - Adds FTA Section 5307 funds and moves to FFY 2025
- 8TD038 Purchase scheduling software, AVL equipment, etc. for DCPT
  - Adds FTA Section 5339 funds to FFY 2025

### 5.a. Federal Transit Funding


- FFY 2025 allocations published by FTA
- Poughkeepsie-Newburgh Urban Area:
  - Section 5307 = \$18.5M (25% decrease from 2024)
  - Section 5310 = \$470K (No change from 2024)
  - Section 5339 = \$1.1M (30% decrease from 2024)
- Finalize suballocations to operators this summer



### New Business






# Planning Updates
