As of July 1, 2019, the Dutchess County Water and Wastewater Authority (DCWWA) is managing the Village of Tivoli water system. As part of an upcoming improvement project, the DCWWA will be replacing the existing water main serving residents and businesses along Broadway and Woods Road in the Village.

The existing water main has surpassed its useful life and is in need of replacement. As part of this work, the DCWWA is taking a proactive approach to reduce the risk of lead exposure to its users by replacing all existing service lines within the project area that are made of lead.

To assist with this effort, the DCWWA is requesting your assistance in determining the water service piping material serving your home/business (i.e. the type of water pipe entering your home/business).

Please take a few minutes to conduct a simple test to determine what type of water service line you have. The voluntary survey will take you through the test step by step.
