

POOL MAINTENANCE WORKER

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:

This position involves responsibility for monitoring the water system making adjustments and generally insuring that a swimming pool facility meets sanitary and operating standards. Cleaning, maintenance work and adjustment of filters and chemical feeders are major responsibilities of this position. The work is performed under the general supervision of a maintenance supervisor or charge person at the pool.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

1. Tests sanitary condition of water and records temperature;
2. Adds proper chemicals to water as required;
3. Checks, cleans and/or lubricates filters, pumps and motors;
4. Hoses down and disinfects pool deck;
5. Vacuums bottom of pool;
6. Checks safety equipment in pool;
7. Checks chemical feeders and sets for night operation;
8. Sweeps and maintains gym floor;
9. Periodically cleans walls in pool area;
10. Replaces submerged pool lights when necessary;
11. Takes inventory of and orders supplies and chemicals;
12. Does related work as required.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:

Good knowledge of the operation of a swimming pool; working knowledge of the operation of motors, pumps, and filters; ability to learn water testing procedures; ability to operate swimming pool cleaning equipment ability to get along well with others; ability to follow detailed oral and written directions; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- EITHER: (A) One (1) year of experience performing work related to one of the technical trades;
- OR: (B) An equivalent combination of training and experience.
